Getting Around in Seaside

Parking: Visitors are allowed to park along Broadway, Holladay, or any side street for free; however, most street parking is limited to three hours. For longer parking while you ntown and the beach, Seaside provides public Seaside Civic & Convention Center: A large open air parking lot just west of the Seaside Civic & Convention Center with the entrance on 1st Avenue. Motor home and bus parking are prohibited in this lot from June 1st

Wyndham Resort at Seaside: A covered parking garage is located just east of the Wyndham Resort at Seaside building, just two blocks south of the open air lot. The trance is near Avenue A and Beach Drive. The publi parking garage sign is located on your immediate right and the first two levels are free and open to the public. There is no overnight parking allowed.

RV, Bus & Motorhome Parking: Visitors driving large vehicles through Seaside who are not staying overnight have a couple of options for parking. Large vehicles are not allowed in the downtown area west of Broadway, and some side streets may be difficult to navigate. Overnight

parking is not allowed anywhere in Seaside. Seaside Visitors Bureau: Parking lot located just north of Broadway by the Seaside Visitors Bureau and North Roosevelt Drive (Highway 101).

Necanicum Drive: Large vehicles can also park along Necanicum Drive, adjacent to the Necanicum River.

Beach wheelchairs are free and available to the public on a first-come, first-served basis for up to four hours at a time. Call the Bob Chisholm Community Center at (503) 738-**7393** for more information or to make a reservation for a beach wheelchair. The 1 ½ mile Prom is also a great place for those with limited mobility to view the Pacific Ocean, Tillamook Head, and spectacular sunsets. The Necanicum River can be experienced along the Riverwalk and Quatat Park on the west side of the river.

Ride the Seaside Street Car: and cheery transportation with an hourly loop through the heart of downtown from 11am to 8pm every Saturday and Sunday starting Memorial Day and running through the end of September. The streetcar is equipped with a bike rack and exact change is necessary. Riding the open air Seaside Streetcar is a fun way to "tour" Seaside. Street Names & Numbers: As you travel through Seaside it's helpful to understand how the streets are named and numbered. Avenues run north-south while streets run east-west. Broadway is the dividing line between north letter of the alphabet; to the north are numbered. The streets are generally named with words in alphabetical order beginning at the beach; address numbers start at the beach and increase going east. Of course, there are always some exceptions, but this generally will help you make your way around Seaside.

Keeping Seaside Beautiful All Year

For over 23 years, Downtown Seaside's streets have been brightened with beautiful hanging baskets full of vibrantly colored flowers. These baskets add so much beauty and charm to the downtown area.


While the baskets are beautiful to look at, there are and Seaside visitors who donate towards the upkeep and maintenance. The Seaside Downtown Development Association raises \$300 per basket to ensure that they are kept healthy and bountiful during the Summer months.

While the flower baskets added color and beauty to Seaside to have something to help our small coastal town stand out and be unique. Since the flower baskets only adorned the lamp posts during the summertime, the idea of adding special lights on the lamp post became the goal. SDDA board members wanted something that would be simple in design but something visitors and locals could connect to life at the beach. Businesses were able to purchase a Starfish to help with the cost of making them and then the upkeep once attached and hung downtown.

Past SDDA Executive Director Dolna Mespelt was a huge supporter of the Winter lighting program and her dream was to have a lighted banner that hung over Broadway for all visitors to see as they drove down the main strip. In 2005 when Dolna passed away, many wanted to donate funds to go towards the lighted banner that she had always dreamed about.

Unique to Seaside, there are anywhere from 45 to 50 Starfish lights hanging from lamp posts and the lighted banner can be see after Halloween and through Spring annually.

On behalf of Laurie Mespelt, Executive Director, the SDDA Board Members and Volunteers, and the Downtown Merchants that all help to make Seaside such a unique and charming coastal destination,








