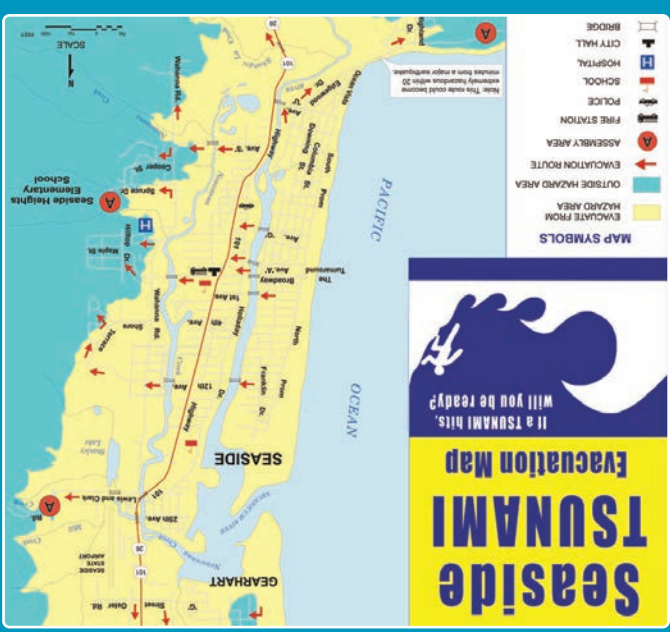

Ride the Seaside Street Car:

During the summer months visitors can explore Seaside on the Seaside Streetcar. The Seaside Streetcar provides convenient and cheery transportation with an hourly loop through the heart of downtown from 11am to 8pm every Saturday and Sunday starting Memorial Day and running through the end of September. The streetcar is equipped with a bike rack and is handicapped accessible. Streetcar fare is \$1 per ride and exact change is necessary. Riding the open air Seaside Streetcar is a fun way to "tour" Seaside. Street Names & Numbers: As you travel through Seaside it's helpful to understand how the streets are named and numbered. Avenues run north-south while streets run east-west. Broadway is the dividing line between north and south Seaside; avenues to the south are in order by letter of the alphabet; to the north are numbered. The streets are generally named with words in alphabetical order beginning at the beach; address numbers start at the beach and increase going east. Of course, there are always some exceptions, but this generally will help you make your way around Seaside.

Safety Tips & Helpful FAQs

What are tides?

Tides are fluctuations of the ocean towards and away from the shore. There are two low tides and two high tides each day. High tides are good for crabbing; low tides are good for clamming, beachcombing, and looking at tide pools.

What is a rip current?

A rip current is a strong current that can pull a person out to sea. If caught in a rip current, don't panic; swim parallel to the beach and eventually the surf will carry you back to shore.

What is a sneaker wave?

A sneaker wave is an unexpectedly large wave that comes further up the beach than other waves. They are strong enough to move logs and can knock over children and adults. Don't turn your back on the ocean.

Lifeguards - One of Seaside's commitments to your safety on the beach is having lifeguards on duty from Memorial Day through Labor Day.

The City of Seaside conducts a test of its emergency system the first Wednesday of every month at 11am. A series of sirens is followed by a voice giving instructions on what to do if this were an actual emergency. The city encourages residents and visitors to be aware of their surroundings and be alert. Hotels, restaurants, and the Seaside Visitors Bureau carry maps and instructions on what to do, what to carry, and where to go.

Getting Around in Seaside

Parking: Visitors are allowed to park along Broadway, Holladay, or any side street for free; however, most street parking is limited to three hours. For longer parking while you enjoy downtown and the beach, Seaside provides public parking within walking distance of downtown (see map). **Seaside Civic & Convention Center:** A large open air parking lot just west of the Seaside Civic & Convention Center with the entrance on 1st Avenue. Motor home and bus parking are prohibited in this lot from June 1st through October 1st.

Wyndham Resort at Seaside: A covered parking garage is located just east of the Wyndham Resort at Seaside building, just two blocks south of the open air lot. The entrance is near Avenue A and Beach Drive. The public parking garage sign is located on your immediate right and the first two levels are free and open to the public. There is no overnight parking allowed.

RV, Bus & Motorhome Parking: Visitors driving large vehicles through Seaside who are not staying overnight have a couple of options for parking. Large vehicles are not allowed in the downtown area west of Broadway, and some side streets may be difficult to navigate. Overnight parking is not allowed anywhere in Seaside.

Seaside Visitors Bureau: Parking lot located just north of Broadway by the Seaside Visitors Bureau and North Roosevelt Drive (Highway 101).

Necanicum Drive: Large vehicles can also park along Necanicum Drive, adjacent to the Necanicum River.



Beach wheelchairs are free and available to the public on a first-come, first-served basis for up to four hours at a time. Call the **Bob Chisholm Community Center at (503) 738-7393** for more information or to make a reservation for a beach wheelchair. The 1 1/2 mile Prom is also a great place for those with limited mobility to view the Pacific Ocean, Tillamook Head, and spectacular sunsets. The Necanicum River can be experienced along the Riverwalk and Quatat Park on the west side of the river.
